free Medical Camp was conducted by MIMS College of Nursing , Puthukode in association with Aster MIMS Hospital, Calicut and Aster MIMS Charitable Trust on 11/11/2018 at Ajmeer Gate Campus, Karad. The 4th Year B.Sc. Nursing students were divided in to different committees such as Registration, Health checkup, BMI monitoring, OP, Lab, Pharmacy, Analysis, Food and Discipline. Each committee was guided by faculty of MIMS College of Nursing. Dr. Assuma Beevi TM, Principal, MIMS College of Nursing guided the faculty and students during the camp. At 8 am the registration was started. The camp was inaugurated by by Mr.Bhagyanathan, Vice president, Vazhayoor panchayat. Community leaders, representatives of Ajmeer gate campus, faculty from College of

Nursing were present during the		
inauguration. After registration, patients		
were guided to BMI, head to foot		
examination and health checkup. Three		
doctors from different department such		
as General Medicine, Obstetrics and		
Gynecology and Pediatrics were		
consulted the patients. After		
consultation patients were guided to		
Pharmacy and Lab. Ms. Shine Thomas,		
Asst.Professor, MIMS CON provided		
counselling services to the needy		
people. Total 321 patients were		
registered in the camp including 163		
males and 158 femalesAmong 321		
patients, BMI level showed that 30 were		
obese and 19 were underweight. BP		
monitoring showed that 45 persons had		
hypertension and 18 had hypotension.		
Total 193 patients checked blood		
glucose level and among them 57 were		
Diabetic Mellitus Patients. Total 159		

patients checked their vision and found			
that 10 persons had visual impairment.			
Blood grouping detection was done for			
59 patients. 60 patients received			
counselling services. All prescribed			
drugs were dispensed at free of cost. 25			
patients were referred to higher centers			
for specialized care. The camp was			
finished by 2.30pm. It was a great			
success in terms of number of patients			
attended and services rendered during			
the camp. Community leaders requested			
MIMS College of Nursing to conduct			
such entities more frequently.			
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
